

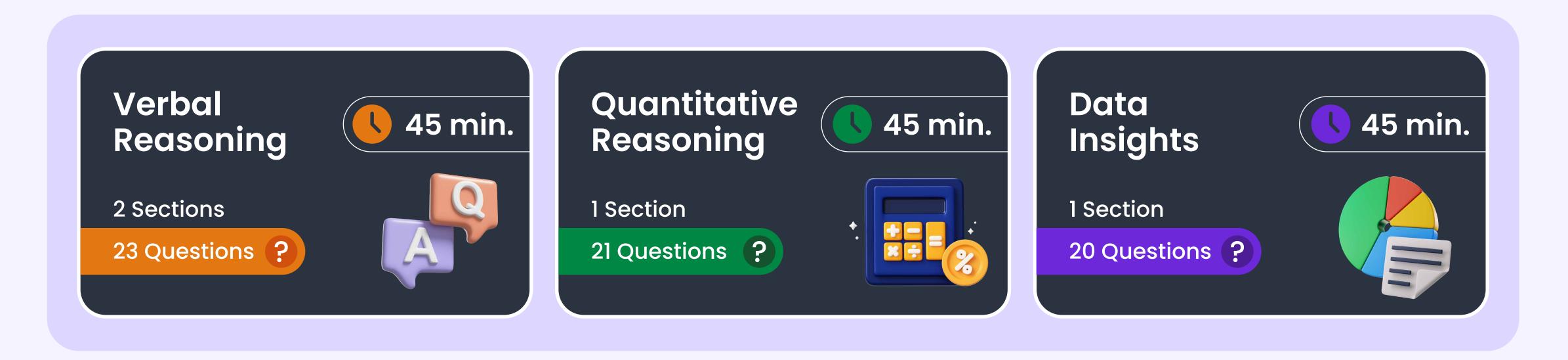

## GMAT Syllabus & Exam Pattern

The GMAT Focus exam is a comprehensive test with a total duration of 2 hours and 15 minutes, including an optional 10-minute break. The exam is divided into three key sections, each designed to assess different aspects of your analytical, verbal, and quantitative abilities.

## GMAT Verbal Reasoning Syllabus

#### Overview: 23 Questions | 45 minutes

- Focuses on Reading Comprehension and Critical Reasoning.
- Tests your ability to interpret, analyze, and evaluate written materials

#### **Key Areas Tested:**

#### Critical Reasoning (CR)

- Identifying flaws and strengths in arguments
- Recognizing assumptions
- Analyzing logical structure
- Drawing logical inferences
- Evaluating and completing arguments

#### Reading Comprehension (RC)

- Understanding main ideas and supporting details
- Inference-based questions
- Applying ideas to new situations
- Evaluating the content or argument in the passage



# **GMAT Quantitative Reasoning Syllabus**

#### Overview: 21 Questions | 45 minutes

- Tests your ability to solve mathematical problems and interpret data
- Focuses on **arithmetic** and **algebra** topics

#### **Key Areas Tested:**

#### **Arithmetic**

- Fractions, decimals, percentages, & ratios
- Basic number properties (powers, roots)
- Counting methods and probability
- Sets and discrete probability

#### Algebra

- Inequalities and absolute values
- Solving linear and quadratic equations
- Understanding functions and exponents
- Exponents applications



# GMAT Data Insights Syllabus

Overview: 20 Questions | 45 minutes

Combines elements of Integrated Reasoning and Quantitative Sections

Tests your ability to analyze, interpret, and integrate data

#### **Key Areas Tested:**

Skill	Description
Multi-Source Reasoning	Synthesize and evaluate information from various sources (texts, tables, charts), draw inferences, and assess arguments.
Table Analysis	Interpret data from tables (statistics, ratios, trends), identify patterns, and compare data points.



# GMAT Data Insights Syllabus

Skill	Description
Graphics Interpretation	Analyze visual data (graphs, scatter plots, pie charts) to understand trends, correlations, and patterns.
Two-Part Analysis	Solve complex problems involving both quantitative and verbal data, analyzing trade-offs and solving equations.
Data Sufficiency	Evaluate if the provided data (from 2 statements) is sufficient to solve the problem.



# GMAT Scoring & Time Management: Expert Tips

Verbal Reasoning

- Reading Comprehension: Scan for structure, focus on main ideas & relationships.
- Critical Reasoning: Ask, "What's the author's assumption?" to speed up decision-making.
- Start Strong: The first few questions matter the most—set a strong tone.

Quantitative Reasoning

- Speed is Key: Answer easy questions in 90 seconds or less.
- Guess Smart: If stuck, make an educated guess.
- Don't Rush on Last 5: Focus on accuracy for the last questions, not speed.

Data Insights

- Multi-Source Reasoning: Triaging helps—ignore irrelevant data quickly.
- Graphics Interpretation: Focus on axes and labels first, then dive into details.
- Two-Part Questions: Break down problems step-by-step, don't rush.
